BULK WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION FROM RAND WATER AND BUNDU WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Thembisile Hani Local Municipality (THLM) hereby informs the community and stakeholders that a potential water supply interruption is expected to occur this weekend (October 4, 2024) as a result of a power failure at the Mapleton and Cullinan/Mamelodi Booster Stations of Rand Water, as well as a power failure at the Bundu Water Treatment Plant (BWTP).

Rand Water encountered an entire power failure at its Mapleton Booster Station on the 28th of September 2024 and at its Cullinan/ Mamelodi Booster Station on the 29th of September 2024, and the power failure occurred due to severe veld fires that burned more than forty (40) wooden pole structures at Cullinan, and the extent of the damage is significant. However, a team has been assigned to replace the burned wooden poles and restore supply, which will be communicated once determined.

On 28 and 29 September 2024, the Bundu Water Treatment Plant was also affected by a power failure as a result of severe thunderstorms, and it is anticipated that the power will be restored at Bundu today (30 September 2024).

The Rand Water reservoirs will experience low levels or become depleted as a consequence of the power failure if power is not restored urgently, and this will affect the water supply to the Municipality, resulting in water supply interruptions in the areas supplied by Rand Water and Bundu Water Treatment Plant this coming weekend, commencing on the 4th of October 2024.



The interruption will affect the following Water Supply Schemes:

The shortfall will be augmented through water tankering in affected areas, and the Municipality regrets the inconvenience that this water interruption may cause and encourages community members to continue to utilising water sparingly during this period.
